THE MILITARY AND HOSPITALLER ORDER
OF SAINT LAZARUS OF JERUSALEM
Association sans but lucratif

Preamble

In the name of God, the Virgin Mary and Saint Lazarus

In the year of Our Lord two thousand and twelve 14th day of September, between the undersigned, acting as founding members:

The National Order of Bohemia, here duly represented by:
Jan Dobrzenský (Grand Priory of Bohemia)
Ondrej Vanke (Bailly of Grand Priory of Bohemia)

The National Order of France, here duly represented by:
Prince Charles-Philippe d'Orléans (Grand Priory of France)
Daniel Blanchet Magon de la Lande (Chancellor of Grand Priory of France)

The National Order of Great Britain, here duly represented by:
Martin Thacker, Baron of Fetternear (Grand Priory of Great Britain)

The National Order of Italy, here duly represented by:
Giovanni Ferrara (Grand Priory of Italy)

The National Order of Spain, here duly represented by:
Enrique Castelló Soler (Grand Priory of Spain)

The National Order of U.S.A., here duly represented by:
Thierry Pauquet de Villejust (Grand Bailiwick of the U.S.A.)

and all those who will join them subsequently, is formed a non-profit association (the "Association") which will be governed by the law of April 21, 1928 on non profit associations and foundations, as amended, and by the following statutes (the "Statutes"):

I. Name - Seat - Purpose - Duration - Fund raising

Article 1. Name

The name of the Association is "The Military and Hospitaller Order of Saint Lazarus of Jerusalem, A.s.b.l.", (the "Order") which can be abbreviated to "OSLJ". Name in Latin is "Ordo militaris et hospitalaris Sancti Lazari Hierosolimitani".

It is established in accordance with the law of April 21, 1928 on non-profit making associations and foundations (the "Law") and shall be registered in the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg.
